

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Cronulla Surf Festival

A VIBRANT, FAMILY-FRIENDLY CELEBRATION OF SURF CULTURE AND COMMUNITY SPIRIT.

The 2025 Cronulla Surf Festival was our biggest and most meaningful yet - a vibrant celebration that brought together **over 15,000** people to share in a day of surfing, music, culture, and connection. Now in its third year, the Festival has grown into more than just an event. It has become a true reflection of the Sutherland Shire's spirit, showcasing our love for the ocean, our pride in community, and our belief in the power of coming together.

At the heart of this year's program was the World's Biggest Paddle Out for youth mental health - a powerful moment where **I,027 people** linked arms in the ocean while thousands more cheered from the shore. Together, we didn't just make history; we **raised \$54,000** to fund vital wellbeing workshops in local schools, proving what's possible when a community unites around a cause.

The Festival also featured live music, surfboard demos, a vintage surfboard display, family-friendly activities, markets, and food trucks - creating a day that had something for everyone. From surfers in the water to families on the sand, the energy was one of joy, unity, and celebration.


- The event has deep penetration into Cronulla & Sutherland Shire — indicating strong local community engagement.






FESTIVAL IMPACT AT A GLANCE

- 1,027 participants in the World Record Paddle Out for youth mental health
- \$54,000 raised to fund mental health workshops in local Shutherland Shire schools
- 6000+ young people directly supported through funded programs to date
- 96% of attendees when asked, reported feeling more connected to their community
- 16 local vendors, food trucks, and market stalls featured




GIVING BACK

These programs are designed to


- Provide students with practical coping mechanisms for stress and anxiety.
